- Do you naturally have a positive, happy and joyful temperament? How do you (does your natural temperament) react to what was taught today in the first point about how the Gospel should create radically joyful warriors? Do you think Paul is setting a standard that is really unattainable in this broken world? Do you aspire to be more joyful? What would being more joyful look like for you? How would being more joyful help you in your life and in all of your relationships?
- Based on Paul's teaching about being aware of falsehood, lies, and evil around us, how can we remain joyful and positive? When as Christians we take a stand with friends or coworkers about a particular social issue that is clearly unbiblical, and we are told we are just being "political", what are some positive replies we can make?
- How does pride hurt you in making strong relationships I your marriage, with your kids and in your relationships at church and work? Do you think you have a healthy/Biblical sense of yourself or do you think you need to work to eliminate pride and move more toward humility. How can a man be humble and confident at the same time?
- How can our loyalty to human spiritual leaders/celebrities or political leaders/parties keep us from being radically loyal to Jesus Christ? In discussing social issues with Christian friends, how can we clarify that in holding the views we hold, we are seeking to be radically Christ-centered? Is this possible? Will they listen? Are our views radically Christ centered?
