RUNNING WITH THE WOLVES- Thriving in Danger- Talk 3 AGGRESSIVE HOLINESS FORGE OVIEDO- Rev. Tom Phillips-Incarnation Church, Oviedo

Aggressive holiness is a choice to intentionally follow Jesus into a life you would never chose on your own...It's a call to "come and die and find new life (MT 16:24-25). It's always good, but its good the way god defines good.

- -Suffering in 1 Peter isn't about unfortunate circumstances out of your control. Instead it is suffering that results from an intentional choice to live as an exile (1:1, 17), and it happens when a heart is captured with an eternal perspective.
